




NADEEN NEWS

Global citizens who care! October topic: World Food Day

Mr. Ben ran an assembly this week about World Food Day...and we had a lot to think about! We learned that there are over 65-million children our age around the world who don't have enough food to eat even though enough food is produced to feed everyone. We also started to think about how to generate less food waste and make good choices. Here are some of the ideas we came up with: **Don't waste food** – Try to only buy what you need. Instead of throwing uneaten food away, try putting it in the freezer to be used another day. Check the use-by dates of food in your house and try to eat it before that date. Remember, food past its sell by date can still be okay to eat, it's the use-by date that is really important. **A meat-free day** – Producing meat uses up a lot of resources. If more people had one meat-free day a week, it would help to save these resources. Let's try "Meatless Mondays" at school from next term as a New Years Resolution! **Save water** – More and more countries are experiencing drought, even in countries where there is enough water. When there is a drought, plants can't grow properly and then there isn't enough food. How can YOU save water at home? **Buy local** – It is a good idea to try to buy food that has been produced near where you live. This is because it uses less energy to transport food that has been produced locally. This is also good for the environment. **What else can your family do?**



Craftsmanship—we are ambitious, determined, and proud




Collaboration—we are flexible, focussed, and show integrity

Confidence—we are individual, independent, and brave




Commitment—we are responsible, engaged, and resilient
