

Start of Year FAQs

1. We have ordered the new uniform and this has not arrived. What should my child wear on Sunday for the first day back at school?

If you have ordered the uniform and it has not arrived. Your child should wear non uniform, with the guidance below:

- *appropriate plain coloured clothing for the first days in this event(plain t-shirt and shorts with appropriate closed footwear).*

2. Do all students need to have aprons? Which year groups need them?

Aprons are not compulsory for our students to purchase at the moment. The aprons are designed for our upcoming food technology curriculum. We are very excited about this.

3. Are the skorts out of stock?

No, we have many in stock, please keep ordering and they will be with you soon.

4. For the first day what are the expectations for the type of bag students need?

No bags with wheels (trolley bag) as we want our students to only bring in the equipment they need each day and also to be safe.

EY to Year2: The rectangular bookbags on the Kapes website are acceptable.

Y3-Y6: Any suitable rucksack is acceptable.

Y7-Y9: Any suitable rucksack is acceptable as long as it fits in their locker.

Please note that the official Nadeen School bag will be available on the Kapes website in the near future.

5. Are hats compulsory?

Yes, all students must have a school branded hat to play outside. We want all students to be safe.

6. What are the expectations for swimsuits?

All students need to wear a swimming cap. Kapes swimsuit must be purchased for all students, nursery and above; however, should modest swimwear be required this can be purchased at any local provider. This must be black.

7. Do the 2 year old students who take part in activities need a uniform?

No. They do not wear a uniform for the activities they are involved in.

8. Is modest wear permitted in conjunction with the uniform?

Yes, this should be white (Top with sleeves) and the Kapes trousers are used. Any other requests can be discussed on a case by case basis.

9. Are Nike leather air force shoes acceptable?

No. Please ensure to wear formal black leather school shoes as per the [uniform FAQ document](#).

10. Can the students wear tracksuits during PE?

Yes, students may wear their Nadeen tracksuits during PE.

11. Is there a return policy at Kapes?

14. What are the pick up arrangements at the end of the day?

This will be sent out by the class teacher as it will be different for year groups. EY, Year 1, Year 2 will be picked up from class. Others will be picked up from the Performance Theatre or teachers will confirm via email on a class by class basis.

15. What happens with my child from the time their class finishes to the bus leaving at 2.45pm. Will there be after care from 12.45pm or 2.00pm up to 2.45pm from the first day?

There will be an activity from 12.45pm to 2.00pm and 2.00pm to 2.45pm. These will be provided free of charge.

16. When will the after school and extracurricular activities be available?

Sunday 10th September will be the launch of the full ECAs. Some clubs and supervision may start before this and parents will be notified.

17. Is there a school canteen?

No, not yet, although we have a few options to consider with meals such as delivery of meals, an external bringing meals on site, etc. All children should bring a packed lunch.

18. When do I find out which house/colour my child should have?

All house information will be distributed by the Teacher at the 'Meet the Teacher' event, Monday 28th August.

19. Will there be a bus provision for all routes?

For non-approved routes the bus company has agreed to provide transport for two weeks until the numbers of these routes increase. However in case the routes are not filled within these two weeks, parents are advised to find alternatives for transport.
